3. This is a fictional story. Can you make a list of all the things that are “not real” in this story?
4. Can you list the things that are “real” in this story?
5. Lizzy Lizard is Swimmy’s best friend. How does Swimmy take care of her? Name three things Swimmy does for her.
6. Can you name the three different places where Swimmy flies the bird, cat, and raccoon to after she removes them from the school?
7. What two lines does Swimmy repeat each time when talking to the bird, the cat, and the raccoon?
8. What pattern does this book follow?
9. Who is your Superhero? Tell your desk neighbor or write a paragraph about him/her.
